


## **Ark Diorama Assembly Instructions**

You can make your own diorama of Noah's Ark! You will need the following items:

 One sheet of cardstock per person (90lb weight cardstock is recommended). This will be used to create the base of your diorama.



- Access to a color printer
- Ark Kit Diorama.pdf (available at <u>www.genesisapologetics.com/lessons</u>)
- Scissors
- Glue dots
- White glue
- One 7¾" long x 1½" wide x 5/8" thick board for each kit. This piece will be used for the hull of the Ark. We used wooden stakes from Home Depot and then cut them to length. **Tip: some stores will cut the board for you for a small fee.**
- One 6<sup>5/8"</sup> x 3/4" wide x 1/4" thick piece of rectangular wood molding for each kit. This piece will be used for the top of the Ark. We bought a short piece of molding from Home Depot and cut it to length.
- A wood file to round the corners of the hull. This is optional.
- Sandpaper to smooth the edges of the hull (optional)
- Some people choose to leave their Ark unstained or color it brown with a magic marker. If you wish to stain your Ark, this should be done with adult supervision! You will need wood stain, brushes, gloves, a drop cloth, and a rag.



## **Getting Started**

- Prepare the wooden hull piece. Sand it and stain or color it as desired. Allow adequate time for the stain or paint to dry before handling it.
- Prepare the wooden top piece. Stain or color it as desired. Allow adequate time for the stain or paint to dry before handling it.
- Download the Ark Kit Diorama.pdf file from www.genesisapologetics.com/lessons.
- Using a color printer, print the Ark Kit Diorama document on cardstock. Be sure to print the document on both sides of the cardstock!

You are now ready to assemble your diorama.

## **Assembly**

Step #1: Write your name on the line provided.

Step #2: Cut off the white borders on the sides and top.

Step #3: Trim off the space around the waves by cutting on the dotted line.


Step #4: Fold the paper along the line shown. Be sure to fold the paper tightly and in the direction shown.


\*Note: for best results, you may want to tighten all of the folds before proceeding to Step #7.

Step #7: place the Ark hull onto the base as shown. Apply a couple of glue dots on the **back side** of the paper that reads "Genesis Chapters 6-9".




## **Ark Diorama Assembly Instructions (continued)**


Step #8: Fold the paper that reads "Genesis Chapters 6-9" onto the glue dots as shown. Make sure the Ark hull fits snugly between this panel and the back of the base.



Step #9: Apply 2 glue dots and a little bit of white glue to the flat side of the Ark top. Note the Ark top should be in the center of the hull.



Step #10: Gently press the Ark top down onto the center of the Ark hull. Allow time for the glue to dry before handling your diorama.
