

Refuting Evolution Part 3: The Fossil Record (Answer Sheet)

Welcome to the third session of our three-part series. What is the Fossil Record? What caused it? Does the Fossil Record support Darwinian Evolution? These are the topics we're going to cover today. Let's get started!

What is the Fossil Record?

The layers of the Earth's surface contain the fossilized remains of literally billions of creatures. Ken Ham, Founder and President of Answers in Genesis, has provided an excellent description of the Fossil Record:

"Billions of dead things, buried in rock layers laid down by water all over the world." Ken Ham


The Geologic Column

Scientists refer to the layers of the Earth's surface as the Geologic Column. According to secular scientists, these layers were laid down over hundreds of millions of years and provide proof that Darwinian Evolution is true. Generally speaking, these layers and the fossils within the Fossil Record were laid down in a fairly consistent pattern.

Since many secular scientists believe the layers represent vast amounts of time, they use periods of time to classify and describe the layers. For example, some dinosaur fossils are found in the CRETACEOUS Period of the MESOZOIC Era.

On the other hand, according to scientists who believe the Bible, most of these layers and the fossils in them were created by the Global Flood described in the book of Genesis. They believe the creatures in the Fossil Record were buried by the habitats they lived in during the one-year flood—not over millions of years.

What viewpoint does the evidence seem to support? Great question! Let's take a closer look!



Does the Fossil Record prove Darwinian Evolution?

Charles Darwin stated that if his theory is true, we should be able to find many fossils of intermediate species—the remains of creatures evolving from one type of creature to another. Although Darwin freely acknowledged the Fossil Record did not contain transitional fossils, he was confident they would eventually be found. It has been nearly 140 years since Darwin died. Since then, we have discovered literally billions of fossils. Was he right?

Characteristics of the Fossil Record


1. Creatures have always been complex

According to evolutionists, fossils that are found in the lowest layers of the Earth represent the earliest stages of evolution. If this is true, the fossils in these layers should be from very simple creatures.

However, scientists have discovered fossils of very complex creatures like trilobites in some of the lowest layers. When scientists examined trilobite fossils under powerful microscopes, they discovered these creatures had compound eyes that each had over 3,000 interconnected lenses to help them see underwater (humans only have one lens per eye). Does that sound like a "simple creature" to you? The Fossil Record reveals astonishing complexity from the very beginning.

2. Creatures are basically the same – they did not evolve (change) into some other type of creature

The Bible teaches that God created all living things according to their kinds. This truth has been confirmed by the existence of "living fossils". These fossils are supposed to be millions of years old, yet look very similar to the creatures living today. Living fossils dating back to the so-called "age of reptiles" (dinosaurs) have been found for every major group of living things including invertebrates, fish, reptiles, amphibians, mammals, insects and plants. Here are four examples of living fossils:


Exercise: please answer the questions below.

What is the significance of living fossils?

Living fossils provide evidence that animals were basically the same in the past as they are today. Although there are some differences, creatures do no change from one created kind to another.

When asked about living fossils, some evolutionists say these creatures did not change much because they were already well adapted for their environment. Yet, during the last 70 million years, whales, bats and humans supposedly evolved from a shrew-like ancestor. Does this explanation make sense to you? Why or why not?

This explanation does not make any sense to me. All of these creatures lived on the same planet and faced similar changes in the environment. Why would lobsters and other creatures that are supposed to be hundreds of million years old show little change, yet shrews supposedly evolved into whales, bats and humans during a much shorter time period?



- 3. **Most fossils were created during the Global Flood described in the book of Genesis.** The Global Flood was a major catastrophe that wiped out billions of living creatures. The Fossil Record provides ample evidence to support this idea including:
 - **Massive fossil graveyards** (example: the Dinosaur National Monument in Utah features a pile of over 2,000 fossilized bones of 11 kinds of dinosaurs in a jumbled mass, together with crocodiles, turtles, lizards, frogs, and clams)
 - Evidence of violent death / drowning (example: dinosaur fossils in the "death pose")
 - Evidence that fossils were buried rapidly (example: fossils of fish eating other fish)
 - Marine fossils on mountaintops (example: 500 giant fossilized oysters on top of the Andes Mountains)
 - Soft tissues in fossils (example: The Institute for Creation Research (ICR) has documented over 40 instances when soft tissue has been found in fossils that are supposed to be millions of years old. Source: <u>http://www.icr.org/soft-tissue-list/</u>)

Question: Over 15 types of soft tissue (example: red blood cells) have been found in fossils that evolutionists claim are millions of years old. Although laboratory experiments show these types of tissues break down quickly and should not be present in these fossils, some of these scientists still insist the fossils are millions of years old. Why do you think this is happening?

Paleontology (the study of fossils) falls into the realm of historical science. Because of this, interpretations of fossil evidence are very subjective. Many people have been taught their entire lives that fossils are millions of years old. They believe that science has proven the Earth is billions of years old and may not realize the problems with radiometric dating. Other people are very set in their ways and are unwilling to consider ideas that conflict with their worldview.


Why does this matter?

You may be wondering why the subject of evolution is so important. Ultimately, it is a question of **our** origins. The Bible clearly states that humans were created by God on Day 6 of creation week (Genesis 1:26-31). People are special since we are the only ones created in God's image (Genesis 1:27). Compare that with these statements below:

"We belong to a highly specialized group of boney fishes...we are fishes whether we like it or not." John Maisey, in Discovering Fossil Fishes, American Museum of Natural History, 1996

As Christians, it is important for us to always be ready to give an answer to those who ask us questions about our faith (1 Peter 3:15). Many people believe that fossils provide proof that Darwinian Evolution is true. They reject the Bible because they think it has been disproven by science (it hasn't of course).
