3. The eruptions of Mount St. Helens rapidly changed the areas around it! Name four changes that resulted from the eruptions.

Large areas covered in deep ash
Rapidly deposited layers of ash and mud
Broken trees / wiped out forests
Trees floating in Spirit Lake
Rapidly created canyons (e.g. Step Canyon)

4. There are at least 300 legends about the Global Flood from all over the world. How and why do you think this happened?

After the Global Flood, God told Noah and his family to spread out and fill the Earth (Genesis 9:7). However, the descendants of Ham, Shem and Japheth (Noah's sons) disobeyed God and stayed in the region of Babel for hundreds of years. When they decided to defy God and build a huge tower, God stepped in and confused their languages. This caused them to stop working on the tower and spread out over the Earth (Genesis 11:1-9). Because the Global Flood was an important element of their history, when the people scattered, they brought the story of the Flood with them.
